

WHO WE ARE

CABUWAZI is a social circus based in Berlin that started in 1994 and now counts six places all around the city (Treptow, Kreuzberg, Altglienicke, Marzahn, Tempelhof, Hohenschönhausen).

We offer circus pedagogical leisure time activities, mostly free of charge for children and youngsters between 4 and 21 years old.


Next to regular training, we organise shows, holiday camps, co-operations with schools, kindergartens and refugee shelters, circus therapy sessions, and circus pedagogical training for teachers (Circus Academy).

Circus is an art form, a way of expressing that goes beyond the spoken language: together with the physical development of the body that circus provides - strength, balance, coordination - it foster trust in oneself and the others.

The European and international youth work, like youth exchanges and volunteering, are also an important part of the activities in CABUWAZI. We are an intercultural project, which thrives from the cooperation among people from different backgrounds.

The specific tasks are different from place to place, but generally this is a list of activities volunteers will carry out:

- preparing circus performances
- support with technical tasks and housekeeping on the place
- public circus actions with the whole volunteers crew
- writing posts in the volunteers's blog
- participating in two seminars with other volunteers In addition, volunteers are more than welcome to plan and start your own mini project. CABUWAZI is a safe ground to try out ideas and make a change in the local level.

Volunteers have a single room in a shared flat, with bathroom and kitchen in common with the other flatmates.

There are five different flats with single rooms and shared common spaces situated in:

All flats are equipped for all basic needs.



Insurance

During the volunteer service volunteers are insured by HENNER. All volunteers will receive an e-mail with ID and PASSWORD to enter their personal profile and a guide with detailed information about which kind of care the insurance covers. We advise to read carefully the guide and print your HENNER card in order to have your log-in information always with you.

- If volunteers have the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC), HENNER is working complementary, covering what the EHIC card is not including.

REALLY IMPORTANT: ALWAYS BRING YOUR EHIC CARD WITH YOU

- If volunteer don't have the EHIC card, HENNER will cover 100% of medical costs.

Language

The Erasmus+ program is providing an online language learning platform called OLS (Online Linguistic Support) that includes:

- language assessments
- language course from basic to advanced
- thematic 'Massive Open Online Courses' (MOOCs)
- tutoring sessions with native speakers and other

Participation to OLS is compulsory and you can benefit from it from the whole duration of your project.

besides, CABUWAZI is organising an intensive language course of 48 hours specifically designed for the volunteers group and focusing on the vocabulary and expressions most needed in the tent.
